Backpacker charged in Australia with disposing of baby she didn't know she was going to have

IRISH GIRL'S STILLBIRTH ORDEAL IN THE OUTBACK

AN Irish backpacker could be jailed for two years for concealing the birth of her stillborn baby in the Australian outback.

The 25-year-old woman, who was working in a remote town in West-

ern Australia, gave birth alone in the hotel where she worked and lived.

It is understood she did not know she was pregnant and delivered the baby without any help or medical care.

She did not tell her friends what had happened for several days, and hid the infant's body. When her friends found

out, they took her to hospital where staff notified police and the woman was charged. The law in Australia requires all births to be reported – even if the baby has died of natural causes.

The woman must stay in Perth until her court case on October 2, despite her family's pleas to bring her home. Sources
